The Aurum Institute is a public benefit organisation focused on frontline healthcare. We have been at the forefront of battling HIV and TB in Southern Africa for the last 22 years. We have over 3000 staff based in the field ready and able to broaden this battle to confront the immediate enemy challenging the very existence of life as we know it, not just in South Africa, but globally - COVID19.

We have already mobilised our frontline teams to assist in a variety of ways. These include providing both our clinical staff and the Dept. of Health with infection prevention tools and training, extensive PPE sourcing and distribution, and community-based COVID19 screening and health assessments.

Our infectious disease experts and doctors are assisting the National Institute for Communicable Diseases as strategic advisors and as extra hands in their call centre. We are busy ramping up our COVID19 response, with teams and vehicles able to quickly respond to Government's call to help trace and test the contacts of identified positive patients.

Protecting frontline doctors and nurses in public health services, tracing and testing for COVID19, and supporting the sick needs to be massively scaled up. Finally, we have been asked to assist with other basic services such as food provision and distribution to the most vulnerable as well as innovation around shelter and basic resources for those being affected economically by this crisis.
